# AROUND THE HOUSES

In future overnight cover will be provided by three overnight sleepers who will work five nights at a time on a rolling rota. Two of these have already been

A new deputy housekeeper will shortly be appointed to provide daytime cover for Julia. A final change to the staffing at Sibley's Orchard is that their gardener, Dyllan is returning to South Africa and we will therefore shortly be recruiting a new gardener/handyman.

As a result of these changes the accommodation previously used for the housekeeper has now been

refurbished as a one bedroom flat for either a couple or a single resident. Although redecoration is not yet complete there has been a number of enquiries and we will be welcoming a prospective resident for a week's trial at the beginning of February.

At St. Mary's House they have been pleased to welcome Barbara who initially will be occupying one of the bungalows but who will shortly be moving in to the main house. The one bedroom bungalows are ideal for someone who would like the support of someone on call and meals provided but who also wishes for more space and greater independence than the rooms in the main house provide.
